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Our Background Story: The name Fernwaters is a tribute to Ethel Fern Philps McFarland and a reference to the Salmon River. Ethel was a mother and grandmother to four Fernwaters founders and a respected teacher in the Salmon River area. The logo was designed by Clay Eichner, one of Ethel's grandsons. It is an S, representing the town of Salmon and the Salmon River. Fern fronds form the ripples in the river.

Fernwaters is a public charter school founded in 2019. Charter schools are free public schools that accept greater accountability in exchange for greater autonomy. Fernwaters is a high expectations, high support school. That means we keep our student to teacher ratio low so that we can hold students to high standards of academic and behavioral performance and support all students in achieving our high expectations. Charter schools are also non-profit organizations. They are funded with state and federal dollars and supplemented by grants and private donations.
